- Designs new projects to meet needs such as the Grief & Healing Program/Collaborative.

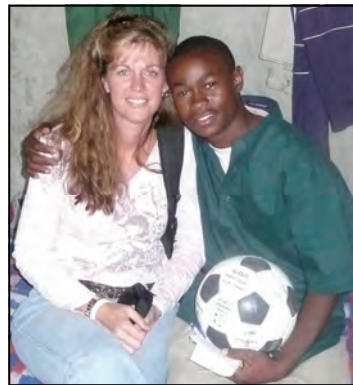


Making Dreams Come True!

Her 88-year old grandmother was struggling to provide for her and keep them together, when she applied to Dream Sponsors to help Elizabeth, who dreamed *only* to be able "to eat, have some clothes, and go to school". Today, 8-year-old Elizabeth is happy and healthy,

At age 15, Peter was an orphan just trying to survive the harsh streets of Nairobi. Despite some help from local programs, he decided to return to his home village to work. In 2008, his village was attacked by a rival tribe, during post-election violence.

Peter witnessed the violent deaths of his fellow tribe members and lost everything when his apartment was burned to the ground. He and his sisters then suffered the deplorable conditions of a resettlement camp. Peter, now 20, lives with a group of former street boys and attends school! With the help of Dream Sponsors, Peter receives support with food, clothing, and school fees so he may achieve his goals.

One Courageous Orphan's Story

Meet Fiston Kahindo, an African orphan who suffered the extreme poverty and violence of slum-living, refugee camps, and political threats. At age 8, both his parents died, and his life changed forever. He and his brother walked from the Congo to find safety in a Kenyan refugee camp.



With support from an African organization, a caring family in the USA, and obtaining a scholarship to Holderness School, Fiston was able to leave his former existence and come to the USA to achieve his dreams. Fiston earned his Bachelor's Degree in International Business, and is now working on his Master's Degree. Fiston has been the voice and inspiration behind the mission of Dream Sponsors, and serves as Board Treasurer. He is committed to helping other orphans make their dreams come true!
